## STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURE FOR THE EXPORTATION OF SAMPLES

- (a) Letter must be addressed to the Commissioner Guyana
  Geology and Mines Commission through the Manager,
  Geological Services Division, requesting assistance for the
  examination and sealing of samples.
  Information such as; origin and destination (addresses) of
  samples, amount and person/company shipping must be included.
  - (b) A similar letter is requested by customs.
- 2. A 'C' 72 custom form must be filled out with the require information
- 3. The samples must be brought to **GGMC** for Examination and Sealing by both **G.R.A/Customs** and **GGMC** simultaneously.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the person/company exporting the sample(s) to provide;
  - (a) Labour &
  - (b) Tools eg. Drills, wire to facilitate the process.
- 5. Only containers with proper covers will be allowed.
- 6. Small amounts of samples may be allowed to be exported without the involvement of customs but with the issuance of a letter from the Commission.
- 7. Very large volumes of samples may be examined at Shipper's location for convenience.
